

40 Saber Units sent to Mali



Just last week, mid October, we sent 40 new **SABER MP3** hand wind players to a project in Mali, West Africa. A new Bible translation for a peoples group has just been completed and will be dedicated in December. Working in conjunction with Wycliffe Bible Translators, Gospel Recordings (Burkina Faso), a Christian charity in Birmingham and ourselves, our Saber units will be used to play the new translation to those who don't or can't read. In this way many of the 800 villages will hear clearly and loudly these precious Words of God in their own language for the first time.

Our team in Burkina Faso travelled to Mali to make the recordings which will be used on the Saber units. This involved much hard work and we are thankful to Jacques and his team there. Also thanks to Michael and the team in Mali for the years of translating the Bible portions into this language.

Please pray for much fruit from this whole project.

As you are aware, for us to give out these machines free we need the money to come in. We are grateful to our friends in Birmingham who have helped pay for this first lot. These 40 units will enable 40 villages to hear - but what about the other 760 villages? Maybe you can help. If you would like to buy or help buy a unit please contact me. The units cost around £30 each, about the cost of half a tank of petrol, but for this amount thousands will hear the precious "Good News" in a language they can understand...their own.
