

Kosova Trip September 2011. Language Recordings UK. "Telling the Story of Jesus in every Language" Our team of six guys set off from Gatwick on the 12th September and arrived in the beautiful sunshine of Pristine airport. After arriving at the church centre we immediately headed out to distribute food and humanitarian aid to many Roma families. A 20 ton load had been sent out on a lorry about 4 weeks before and we had the joy of giving some of it out, working alongside the local church team. The families we delivered to were delighted as many didn't have any food. Many of the families

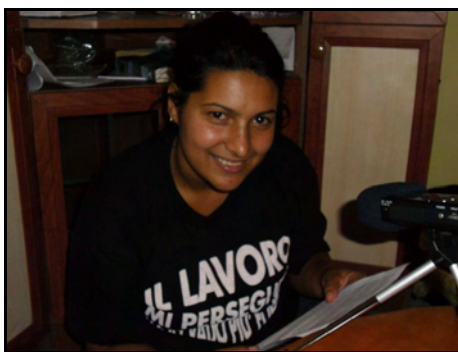


have a lot of kids. One family we visited had 12 children, no water and very basic housing. Another young family of mum, dad and six young boys with one on the way soon, came to the church centre, to get a shower, hair cuts, old clothes replaced with new ones, new shoes, a big meal, and sent home with loads of food and extra clothes. The mum said it was the first shower she had ever had. The boys loved the hot



water for the first time.

We travelled to Tirana, the capital city in Albania, about 4 hours away to record in the Albanian language with a young Bible College student. Her family live in a scrap yard and the background noise of a dogs barking, hammering metal, the noise of sorting out plastic bottles and her young siblings coming in every so often haha made this a challenge, but we got there. The girl hopes to finish her Bible College course at some time in the future.



We also visited a new church in northern Albania and its growing fast. We delivered lots of aid to the poor families. Each of our team carried a 20 Kg bag of flour on our shoulders up hill for about 15 minutes to some Roma families and I thought I was back doing football training again haha. We were all glad to reach the top and couldn't speak for about 10 minutes haha). We were delighted that many had been baptized quite recently and their families can see the change in their lives, Praise The Lord.



About our team... Every morning the guys woke up with a smile on their face as they loved giving out aid and our recordings. They led kids clubs, worship, games, preached and told Bible stories and testimonies. We made visits to the local fire station, the police station, schools, medical centres and gave out computers, books, shoes, clothes and



our recordings in Albanian. We challenged the police team to a 7 a side football match...we got thrashed 14-4 I think the score was. They were a brilliant fit team...we were very poor, but really enjoyed the game. I got to kick the police chief oopps!!!

Our focus was to take The Gospel message to these folk whatever their background and this we did in conjunction with giving out aid and having time for people and to build relationships. There is so much need in this place and we are continually shocked at the desperate living conditions many hundreds of families live in and with no one to turn to. Jesus died for these people and loves them like He loves us. We pray that many will turn to Jesus and find peace and a new life in Him. I'm always reminded of James 2 v 14-18 and 1 John 3 v 16-19 when I visit Kosova and other places. Please pray for all these people, many without any hope.
