

Slovakian Recording Trip - April 2009.

Before every recording trip we pray and ask others to pray for us as we travel to new places. Sometimes it is easy to forget that we are in a battle for souls and the enemy doesn't always encourage us to take Gods Good News to other people. For instance the last 2 trips we have made our car has broken down. Last time about 2 miles from the airport. This time it was the night before when we left the office at 5.15pm our fan belt had broken and all the garages were closing... except for our garage! We set off at 4.30 am for an early flight from London Heathrow to catch our flight to Bratislava via Prague in the Czech Republic. We had been in touch with her for some months by e-mail and had sent her the translations we wanted to record. She had worked so hard on the translations for several months. It was great to meet her face to face. She welcomed us to Bratislava as we travelled by taxi to our accommodation. Within a few hours we began recording in her language. She

In the evening we spent time with her and her husband and next day we were able to have a short visit into the centre of Bratislava and learnt a wee bit about the



amazing history of this country. In the afternoon we returned to the airport for our trip back home to the UK.

We arrived home around midnight and ready for Good Friday and The Easter weekend.
